



## Medical Rides

Volunteer drivers use their own vehicles to provide rides to medical and dental appointments for people who have no other transportation options, and who can walk with minimal assistance.

- Limit your request to one ride per week. Medical Rides can be out of the Roseville School district but pre approved.
- All riders are required to use seat belts.
- Seek alternative transportation in case we cannot accommodate your medical ride request.
- Call us as soon as possible if you need to cancel your ride.
- The rider is responsible for parking fees.

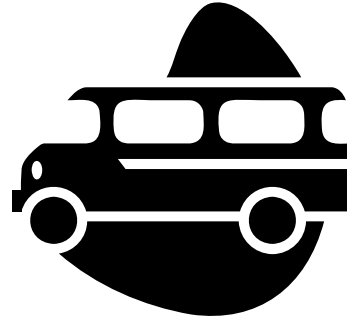

## Shuttle Bug Bus Service

Our bus provides transportation service to locations within Roseville School District 623 (Roseville Area Senior Program, shopping, banking, recreation, etc.) The routes vary daily, depending on the number of riders and their destinations.

- The bus is lift-equipped with one wheelchair space.
- The bus and drivers are Special Transportation Services certified.

## Standing Orders For Shuttle Bus Service

Standing orders may be scheduled for rides that take place on a regular basis. They need to be at the exact time and the same pick up and drop off destination.

## Cancellations

Please call us as soon as possible if you need to cancel your ride. The demand for rides far exceeds the trips we are able to provide. Also, it is very costly and creates scheduling problems if you are not ready to travel once we arrive at your home.

## Closed Dates

Transportation will not be available on days the Senior Program is closed. Closed dates will be published in the Seasons newsletter, and posted on the Shuttle Bug Bus.
